## AQUATIC FACILITIES CONSIDERED

THE Federal Government is making available up to \$45,000 to the City of South Perth through the Community Development Grants Program.

The funds are to be used for a feasibility study for a new aquatic centre in the Manning-Karawara precinct.

Swan MHR Steve Irons has been campaigning for a

new aquatic centre since 2011.

“The people of the City of South Perth have indicated in multiple community surveys and meetings that aquatic facilities are a priority,” he said.

“A possible location for aquatic facilities is the George Burnett Leisure Centre site in Karawara. The

City has indicated that a detailed feasibility study is required to consider the idea and the Federal Government has provided this opportunity.”

City of South Perth Mayor Sue Doherty said a report regarding funding for the feasibility study would be considered by council at this month’s meeting.
