



CCTV to keep an eye on shops

BELMONT

THE perimeter of Belmont Forum and Belmont Village will be monitored by CCTV in a bid to put a stop to the number of break-ins at the shops.

The Federal Budget allocated \$100,000 for CCTV in Belmont and Swan MHR Steve Irons visited the site with Justice Minister Michael Keenan on Friday, May 30.

“The City of Belmont has supported this commitment because CCTV is already working to make Belmont safer,” MR Irons said.

“In Belmont, between January and August 2013 some 48 incidents involving Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) were given to the police with 20 positive results where offenders were identified and prosecuted, 24 filed pending further information and four under investigation.”
